Job Summary:

As a Bartender Tier I at Granite Gorge Mountain Park, you will be responsible for providing excellent customer service, preparing beverages, and maintaining a clean and organized bar area. This role does not include supervisory duties but requires close interaction with guests and teamwork with other staff to ensure a positive experience for all visitors.

Key Responsibilities:

Customer Service & Interaction:

- Greet and serve customers in a professional and timely manner, as per training guidelines.
- Interact in a professional, friendly, and courteous manner with all guests, promoting a guest service culture.
- Check in with customers to ensure their experience is satisfactory and handle various impromptu
 requests.

Beverage & Food Preparation:

- Prepare alcoholic, non-alcoholic, and other beverages for customers and servers in accordance with standard recipes.
- Prepare all condiments to garnish drink orders and ensure customers eating at the bar have the appropriate tableware.
- Process food orders and enter them into the POS system.

Bar Maintenance & Stocking:

- Refill ice wells, change beer kegs, and restock napkins and straws regularly as needed.
- Keep the bar stocked with liquor, syrups, glasses, napkins, and all other necessary items before and during service hours.
- Maintain a clean bar at all times, wiping the bar regularly, disposing of debris and bottles, and washing glasses as needed.
- Remove dirty dishes and trash, clean up spills, and organize the counter.
- Check and maintain stock of glassware, beverages, and bar supplies, and communicate shortages to management.

Compliance & Safety:

• Ensure all customers are of legal drinking age.

- Adhere to all restaurant/bar policies and procedures, with special attention to health and safety protocols.
- Uphold sanitation and food safety principles.
- Communicate health and/or safety concerns/violations immediately to management.
- Obtain and upkeep all required certifications.

Teamwork & Support:

- Assist other staff with duties when assistance is needed, including covering for staff members who are out.
- Follow company policies and procedures to ensure compliance with all applicable state or federal laws.
- Perform other duties or projects as assigned.

Other Duties as Assigned:

Perform other duties as assigned to support the overall success of Granite Gorge Mountain Park.

Qualifications:

- Knowledge: Proficient in alcohol and mixed drink preparation.
- Age Requirement: Must be 18+ years of age.
- **Skills**: Strong verbal communication, positive attitude, strong customer service, problem-solving, multitasking, prioritizing, and time management.
- Work Ethic: Ability to take direction, follow recipes, and maintain cleanliness in a high-pressure environment.
- **Team Player**: Demonstrates a strong work ethic, adaptability, and professionalism.
- Independence: Ability to work independently and take initiative.
- **Professionalism**: Must handle high-stress situations with diplomacy and maintain an enthusiastic and proactive attitude.
- **Technology Skills**: Basic technology skills and the ability to quickly learn and adapt to using point-of-sale (POS) systems and relevant software.
- Transportation: Must have reliable transportation, especially in winter New England weather conditions
- Flexibility to work evenings, weekends, and holidays as needed.
- The ability to obtain ServSafe Alcohol Certification
- The ability to obtain NH TIPS On Premise Alcohol Training Certification
